SCOPE OF CONTEST:

Competitors will be required to test their skills in the following areas:

- 25 QUESTION TEST (25 MINUTES) will be given for Esthetics in the beginning of the competition. The best score/grade will be used to break a tie if it exists.
- BASIC FACIAL (30 MINUTES) Demonstrate a basic facial including cleansing, analysis, massage, mask, toner and moisturizer.
- DAYTIME MAKE-UP (30 MINUTES) Demonstrate a complete daytime makeup application including contour, cheek color, foundation, eye makeup, and lip color. Must conform to model's skin tone and applied to the face and neck only.
- FANTASY THEMED MAKEUP APPLICATION (60 MINUTES) (Optional: Daytime makeup may be used as a base for the "Animal Kingdom" makeup) Demonstrate themed makeup application using all makeup products designed for use on the face that include: grease paint, false eyelashes, rhinestones, feathers, and theatrical accessories. Reference pictures may be displayed at the station.
- Items such as jewelry, scarves, hats, wigs, etc. WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND COULD RESULT IN LOSS OF POINTS.
- No latex items due to allergies.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Anything else competitors may need to know:

• Students will not be permitted to use the Internet or printed materials for reference.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

- All contestants must follow infection control and safety procedures before and during the contest.
- All implements and supplies used must be clean and sanitary
- The contestant is expected to leave the station clean and in an orderly fashion. Blood spill kit is supplied by the contestant.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED:

- No airbrushes will be permitted for makeup applications.
- No CELL PHONES, SMART WATCHES or two-way radios are permitted. If a contestant is found to have either in their possession, they will be immediately disqualified.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- All products must be properly identified with the manufacturer's original packaging and labeling. No defacing of labels is permitted.
- The host school and judges reserve the right to check all toolboxes and/or materials prior to the contest. Any tools that are deemed questionable and would give an unfair advantage to a contestant will not be permitted and will be discarded prior to the start of the competition.
- There will be no conversation between contestant and model or any talking on the floor once the competition has started. Any talking could result in disqualification of the contestant and model.
- Contestant may not leave the contest site until they are dismissed.
